The Queen's Law Students' Society Spark Award shall be presented annually to a first year law student who, in the opinion of the selection committee, has best demonstrated commitment to the Law School. Participation and dedication in such areas as:

- (a) student and faculty government
- (b) social activities
- (c) extracurricular clubs, societies and organizations
- (d) athletic competition

shall be qualifying criteria. The selection committee will consider readiness to participate in Law School activities, readiness to volunteer assistance where assistance is needed and general enthusiasm to enter into the community of Law School.

Any student in first-year law shall be eligible for consideration for the award.

Any student in first year of law school may submit nominations for the award to the Chairperson of the Committee who may consider any student eligible to receive the award, whether or not he/she has been so nominated.
