

Student Financial Aid NEEDS-BASED FUNDING

Currently, at Queen's Law, **1 in 4** students has financial need. There are two types of financial awards offered through Queen's University – **merit-based** and **needs-based**. The Student Awards Office at Queen's University directly administers all financial assistance programs to help students finance their legal education. Students requiring needs-based awards express their requirement for financial need when applying for Queen's bursary assistance. In 2020-2021, there was **\$889,692** of needs-based funding disbursed to **177** first to third year law students.

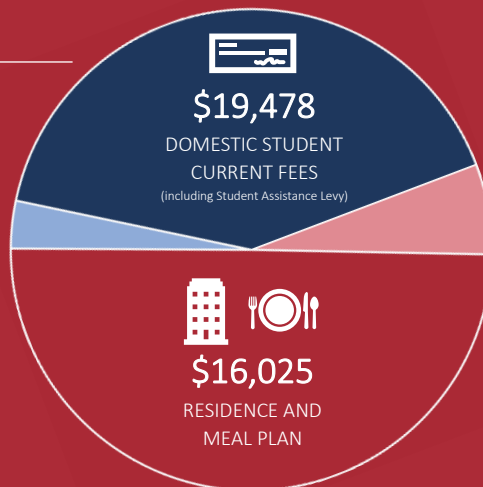
