## What's different?

- First-year courses: 36 credits
- Credit Requirement: 59 Upper-year credits
  - Business Associations (440: fall only) & Civil Procedure (225: winter only) in 2L
  - Legal Ethics & Professionalism (334) in 2L or 3L
- Substantial term paper requirement, either 2L or 3L
- Practice skills AND Advocacy requirements (3 credits in each)
- Residency requirement: First-year courses and a minimum of 28 upper-year credits must be taken in residence at Queen's Faculty of Law
