Process:

A request for a deferral of admission for a period of one year may be granted if the applicant would be competitive for admission in any cycle in the category of admission claimed, there are good reasons to support the request and the request is not brought very late in the application cycle. Admittees who are granted a deferral will be required to change their acceptance from provisional to firm as a condition of the grant of a deferral. If an entrance scholarship or a law admission bursary was offered in the admission cycle, the applicant will forfeit that scholarship or bursary, but should notify the Assistant Dean of Students that s/he would like to re-considered for an entrance scholarship in the next admission cycle. If a deferral is granted, the applicant must notify the Assistant Dean of Students before the end of January s/he is planning to register the following September. The deferred applicant may reapply for a law admission bursary in the following admission cycle.
