## Smudge (9:15am – 9:45am – Optional)

#### (The Smudge will start promptly at 9:15am, so please arrive on time)

Location: Back Courtyard between Macdonald Hall and Dunning Hall (site of the Kick-off BBQ) Ann Deer our Indigenous Recruitment and Support Coordinator will be hosting a smudge ceremony. All students are welcome. Smudging is traditionally done as a way of purifying or cleansing the soul of negative thoughts of a person or place. There are four elements involved in a smudge:

- The container, traditionally a shell representing water, is the first element.
- The four sacred plants (cedar, sage, sweetgrass, tobacco), gifts from mother earth, represent the second element.
- The fire produced from lighting the sacred plants represents the third element.
- The smoke produced from the fire represents air, the fourth element.
