  - How participation in the Pre-Law Support Program will support your preparation for legal studies.
- Up-to-date academic transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended (unofficial transcripts are acceptable for this application).
- Current resume outlining academic, professional, leadership, and community experiences.
- Information regarding your planned timeline, including when you intend to write or re-write the LSAT and the anticipated year you plan to apply to law school.
