Language of instruction Language requirements	<p>English (only)</p> <p>Students who want to participate in Bachelor's (LL.B) or Master's courses (LL.M) will require a good working knowledge in English Language. However, we don't require formal proof of fluency.</p>

A nomination letter or an e-mail from the home university with the name, study period and email address of the student that has been selected to apply for the Exchange Program at the National Law University Delhi has to be sent to: internationalrelations@nludelhi.ac.in. 2. Information/instructions on application process will be sent by e-mail to each selected student directly. 3. All required application documents have to be sent electronically.
