Application Procedure	 A complete application comprises: An online nomination from the partner institution. A transcript of grades in English A letter from the partner institution confirming that credits earned at TAU Faculty of Law will be applied toward a degree from that university. A proof of English proficiency (if required) A personal statement describing your background, academic or professional interests and goals, and motivation to study at TAU. A photocopy of the first page of the passport. A current photo (jpg format) to be used for the student ID card.
