

A request for a deferral of admission for a period of one year may be granted if the applicant would be competitive for admission in any cycle in the category of admission claimed, there are good reasons to support the request and the request is not brought very late in the application cycle. Admittees who are granted a deferral will be required to make a firm acceptance as a condition of the grant of a deferral. If an entrance scholarship or a law admission bursary was offered in the admission cycle, the applicant will forfeit that scholarship or bursary, but will be considered the next admission cycle.
