Gain a global legal perspective

Since 2001, more than 1,100 law students have participated in our intensive and integrated summer programs in International Business Law (IBL) and Public International Law (PIL). The programs begin with 3 weeks at Queen's, and for the remainder of the time the programs are based at Bard College in Berlin, Germany.

8 Weeks & 9 Credits

Each program consists of 3 three-credit upper-year courses taught by leading practitioners and academics. The courses, guest speakers, field trips, and activities give students a comprehensive and practical introduction to international law and careers in the field.

Visit international courts and organizations, Canadian missions, and law firms in Paris and Geneva (IBL) or The Hague and Geneva (PIL).

Benefit from guest lectures, career and networking events, and academic and cultural tours and activities. Travel throughout Europe on field trips and weekends.

Recent instructors have included lawyers from leading law firms, Global Affairs Canada, the Department of Justice, and the UN; former prosecutors at international criminal tribunals; a Canadian ambassador; and law professors from Queen's and McGill.
